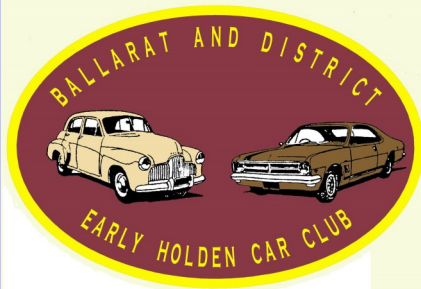

By the time you read this our alarm system for the club rooms should be updated allowing us to move with the times.

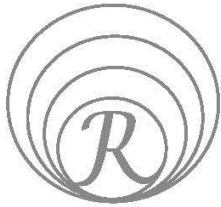
That's it for me thanks to all our members that make our club one of the best.

Red Dog Run—March 2024

The 27 March 2024 Red Dog Run saw thirteen Ballarat & District Early Holden Car Club members meet at Macca's in Lucas for morning tea and the usual chat, not all of which was about their Holdens, or in the case of two members their 'phhhhh' Fords.

At 10.45am the members headed off to Sebastopol and reconvened at Premier Plumbing Services in Hertford Street, where they were met by Grant Donald, one of the Directors of Premier Plumbing. Grant explained that Premier Plumbing was set up by his father Neville F. D. Donald and his mother Vawyn in 1951. In the following 73 years the company has grown to 30 employees, eight of whom are from the Donald family.

Neville Donald was a member of the Sebastopol Council for many years, and between 1966 and the 1994 amalgamation with Ballarat, was Mayor ten times. The memorial park beside the former Sebastopol Council Offices in Albert Street Sebastopol is named the Neville F. D. Donald Park.

On entry to the office area of Premier Plumbing the first thing that is seen is the company's museum. The museum is chock full of memorabilia from the company's history. It includes photographs, certificates and plumbing pieces from the history of the company.

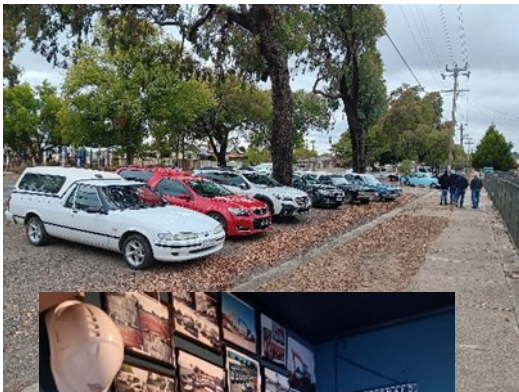
Grant showed all the large 1927 wall map of Ballarat that includes all the sewerage pipes in the city from Macarthur Street to the south. We were then shown a couple of the family's 'pride and joy' pieces of memorabilia: a 1954 Ford Mainline Utility and a 'Cranvel Digger' (an early trenching machine). The digger was purchased some years ago after it was seen in an advertisement for sale in Creswick. On purchasing the digger Neville was told that it had been bought partly restored, but in pieces, from Avoca, but was actually the first digger that Neville Donald had purchased many years earlier.

Outside Grant, showed us a few other pieces of their collection: a modern Monaro, a WB Ute and two Honda motor cycles. Grant and his brother Jim were thanked by the members for their time, effort and interest. Having been thanked, Grant then proceeded to present each of the visitors with a stubby holder containing Premier Plumbing pens, a pocket knife and a small notebook.

Many thanks to Grant and Jim for their generosity. Thanks also to Paul Irvin (who could not attend as he was in Charlton) for arranging the visit.

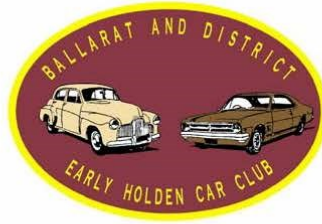

Club Run Etiquette

There is nothing better than sharing our love of cars with a group of likeminded enthusiasts out on the road, and we encourage all members to join us on our club runs. You can come along in any car, it doesn't need to be old, and it doesn't even need to be a Holden. It's about getting out as a group and enjoying each other's company, not about what we're driving.

However, there are a few simple protocols to ensure everyone has a good day...

- Always RSVP to the Run Coordinator and let them know if you change your mind. It's helpful to know how many are expected and saves the group waiting around for a no-show who's changed their mind.
- Listen to the pre-run briefing to get a basic understanding of the route and more importantly the destination. Blindly following the car in front is great - while they're there.
- If the weather forecast issued the night before a run is over 35 deg C, then the run will most likely be cancelled. Keep an eye on the App for any updates.
- Get to the departure point on time – or phone ahead if you're going to be late.
- Out on the road, work off the car behind, not the car in front. In other words, keep the car behind in your mirrors and adjust your speed accordingly. Don't try to catch up to the car ahead. This helps ensure the group stays together.
- Make sure the car behind has seen you when turning a corner - wait at the turn until the car indicates before continuing, then they will wait for the next car etc. Don't be concerned about losing contact with the car in front, as they should be looking out for you.
- Leave a reasonable gap between you and the car in front so that other motorists can overtake if they wish.
- If you're joining us on route, make sure the Run Coordinator knows of your pickup point to ensure we take that route. Also be ready to roll as the convoy approaches.
- We don't leave anyone stranded on the road - if you lose sight of the car behind, pull over and wait. If they don't appear, turn around to render assistance.
- Always follow the car in front. If you think they've taken a wrong turn then let's all take the wrong turn. It's better the club gets lost together than splits up in all directions – it also saves the person behind you having to make a split decision as to who they trust the most!
- Remember it's a club run, not a club race. If there's a tired old grey in front, so be it - enjoy it for what it is. Who cares if you're late in your 308.
- Generally, the return trip from the destination is up to you – but let the 'Run Coordinator' know when you're heading off.

Following these simple pointers will help ensure everybody has a good day – together!
